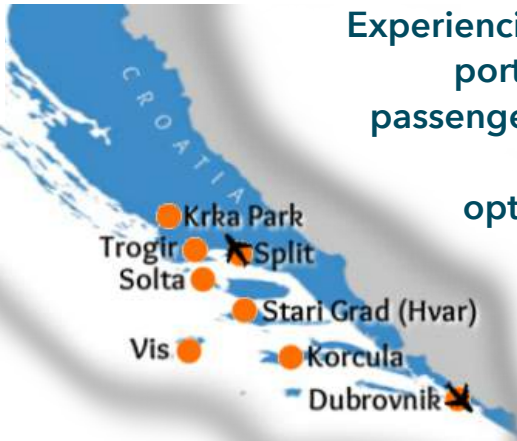

DETAILED ITINERARY

DAY 0 | Depart the USA | Thursday, September 10th

Travel from the US to Dubrovnik, Croatia.

DAY 1 | Arrive Croatia | Friday, September 11th

Arrive in Dubrovnik. A greeter will meet you and assist with transfer to the beautiful Sun Gardens Hotel.

Enjoy the rest of the day and evening at leisure. Feeling energetic? Rent a kayak to explore the beautiful Adriatic.

DAY 2 | Dubrovnik | Saturday, September 12th

Check out of hotel and transfer to Old Town Dubrovnik for a guided walking tour, including cable car ascent to a stunning viewpoint. Lunch on own and free time before transfer to the port to embark m/v Black Swan.

After settling into our cabins, we'll have dinner while we enjoy a sunset cruise past the iconic City Walls.

DAY 3 | Slano, Korčula | Sunday, September 13th

We'll set sail this morning for the coastal village of Slano, from where we depart for a fun excursion to Ston – surrounded by medieval walls (2nd largest in the world).

We'll visit an oyster farm to learn and have a taste!

Back onboard, we'll cruise to the medieval treasure of Korčula, where we'll have a guided walking tour with Andrea – a local legend. We'll enjoy dinner together at our favorite seaside restaurant, Filippi.

DAY 4 | Vis | Monday, September 14th

After a 5-hour cruise, we'll arrive to the island of Vis, the furthestmost inhabited island from the coast. It was a restricted military base until 1989, so its natural beauty hasn't been spoiled by development.

We'll enjoy a leisurely afternoon and evening in the ancient town of Vis, situated at the foot of a horseshoe-shaped bay. Explore its coastal promenade, crumbling townhouses and narrow twisting alleyways.

DAY 5 | Hvar | Tuesday, September 15th

Captain Denis will get a jump on the crowds by taking us to the popular Blue Cave early this morning – before all the other boats arrive!

Time permitting, we'll visit the pretty port of Komiža before setting sail for Starigrad, on the island of Hvar

where we've planned a WOW! surprise for you! Tiny Starigrad is one of the oldest towns in Europe – and one of our favorites!

DAY 6 | Šibenik | Wednesday, September 16th

After several hours of leisurely sailing time, disembark in the port of Skradin for an excursion to Krka Waterfalls. Be prepared to be "wowed" by its natural beauty!

Later on – another "WOW" – at Bibich Winery. Anthony Bourdain said of Bibich, *"I can't believe it took me so long to get here. This is f***** awesome!"* An unforgettable gourmet experience is planned for you this evening.

DAY 7 | Trogir | Thursday, September 17th

The Venetians got around, as evidenced by Trogir's abundance of beautiful buildings from Romanesque and Renaissance times, which earned it UNESCO Heritage status in 1997. The town is set within medieval walls on a tiny island, linked by bridges to both the mainland and to Čiovo Island.

On hot summer nights, everyone hangs out at the seaside promenade lined with bars, cafes, and yachts. You're free to enjoy dinner wherever you like.

DAY 8 | Solta | Friday, September 18th

A lovely, wooded island, Solta is a popular getaway for residents of busy Split. Captain Denis will anchor in a sheltered cove for some leisurely swim time.

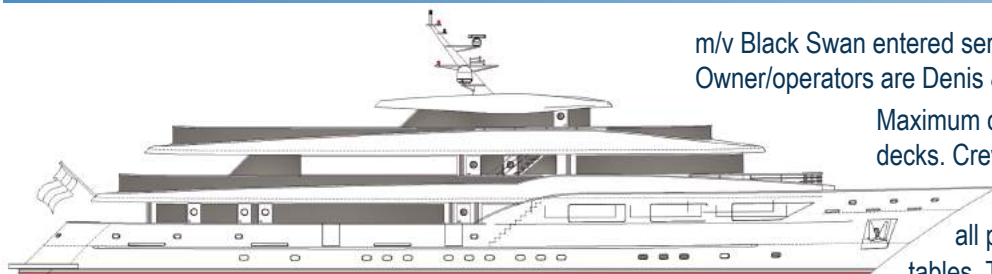
Maslinica is the island's prettiest settlement, with the vibe of a fisherman's village, great beaches, and restaurants. The town center is a smattering of stone houses clustered around a deep bay. It's a great spot for sunset cocktails and our Farewell Dinner.

DAY 9 | Disembark Split | Saturday, September 19th

- 2) If you cannot spare more time, transfer to the airport for your flight home.

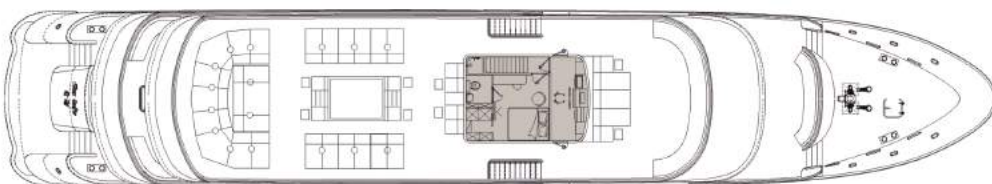
BLACK SWAN DECK PLAN



m/v Black Swan entered service in 2018. She is 160-ft long and 28-ft. wide. Owner/operators are Denis & Anja Grubiša.

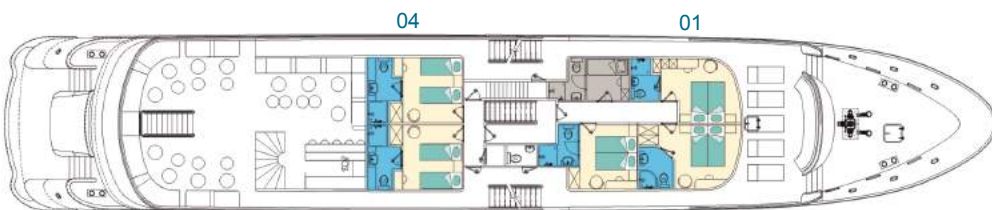
Maximum capacity is 38 guests in 18 staterooms on three decks. Crew of eight plus a Croatian Tour Leader onboard.

The dining room (Main Deck) accommodates all passengers in a single seating at four large tables. The lounge (Upper Deck) is comfortable for guests to enjoy cocktails and socializing under cover.



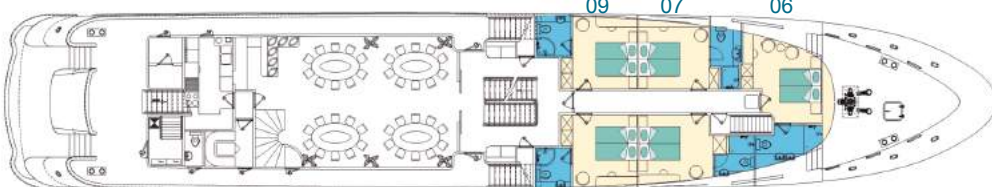
Sun Deck

The Sun Deck offers partially shaded lounge chairs and a Jacuzzi.



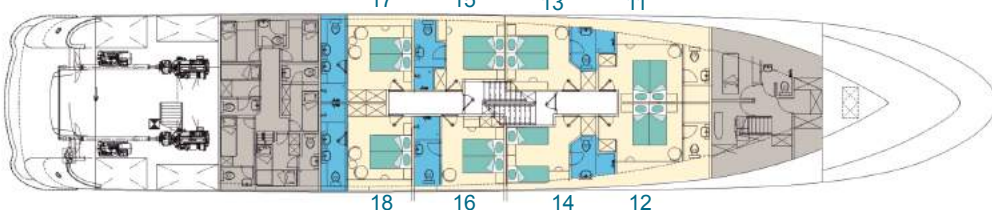

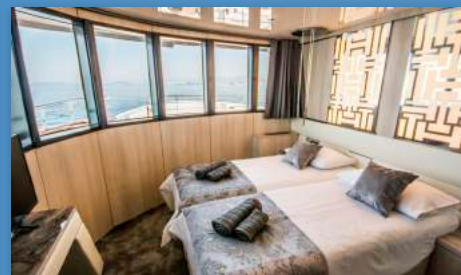

FINE PRINT

TERMS & CONDITIONS | Croatia Cruise

AIR TRANSPORTATION:

You may make your own flight arrangements or WOW Travel can assist for a \$75 per person service fee. Mileage tickets or upgrades must be booked directly with the carrier. If you would like us to assist, contact Howard Wise (howard@thectpgroup.com or 818-444-2710). It is the responsibility of the traveler to provide the legal name as on the passport. Carriers may deny boarding if name on ticket does not EXACTLY match name on passport.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

Space is limited. Reservations are first-come, first-served. Staterooms will be assigned based on date of registration.

- Deposit: \$1,000 per person due at time of registration
- Final payment: Balance due June 12, 2020

CANCELLATION:

If unforeseen events happen that force you to cancel, we will try to resell your space. Penalties vary depending on the date of cancellation:

- From time of booking to March 16, 2020: Full refund minus \$250 service fee, per person.
- From March 17, 2020, to June 12, 2020: Forfeiture of deposit(s).
- On or after June 13, 2020: No refund.

SUPPLEMENTAL TRAVEL INSURANCE:

We recommend "trip cancellation insurance" to cover financial penalties if you need to cancel or interrupt your trip due to unforeseen reasons, medical expenses and emergency transportation, travel delays/missed connections, and baggage protection. Certain plans include coverage for Pre-Existing Medical conditions, financial default, and "Cancellation for Any Reason." Coverage varies by product. Please note that most insurance companies require you to purchase insurance within 14 days of the initial deposit date in order to be covered for pre-existing conditions.

RATES:

All rates are based on tariffs and exchange rates in effect as of August 29, 2019, and are subject to change. Unused tour items, missed meals or activities, etc. are not refundable.

TIPS & TAXES:

The package includes all service charges and taxes imposed by ship and ports and all entrance fees to museums, etc. Basic gratuities to drivers, guides and porters are included. You are welcome to extend additional gratuities for anyone who has provided exemplary service.

BAGGAGE:

Please check applicable baggage allowances and fees with your international airline carrier. For internal Croatian flights, checked baggage allowance on Croatian Airlines is 23 kg (50 lbs). Overweight luggage and/or additional checked bags can be purchased directly from Croatian Airlines.

PASSPORT/VISA:

You must have a valid passport with at least 6 months validity from the date of re-entry to your home country. No visa needed.

HEALTH/VACCINATIONS:

There are no unusual requirements for travel to Croatia. However, you may wish to consult your physician for recommendations. Additional information regarding Traveler's Health precautions is available at the website for the [Centers for Disease Control \(CDC\)](#).

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:

Final travel documents will be sent to your mailing address about two weeks prior to departure.
